## **ORDINANCE NO. 2022-17**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" AS IT PERTAINS TO OFF-DUTY POLICE AND PUBLIC WORKS FEES

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, as follows:

- Subsection **2-5.2(J)** entitled "Employment of Off-Duty Police Officers", paragraph 3, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 3. All persons or entities shall pay to the chief financial officer of the Borough of Harvey Cedars such hourly sum of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars an hour for such service. The borough shall remit to the member of the police department performing such duties eighty (\$80.00) dollars an hour and the remaining twenty (\$20.00) dollars shall be retained by the borough for administrative expenses and vehicle expenses.
- Subsection **2-6.3** entitled "Employment of Off Duty Public Works Employees", paragraph C., is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - C. All persons or entities shall pay to the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Harvey Cedars such hourly sum of eighty (\$80.00) dollars an hour for such service. The Borough shall remit to the public works employee performing such duties sixty (\$60.00) dollars of said hourly rate, and the remaining twenty (\$20.00) dollars shall be retained by the Borough for administrative expenses and vehicle expenses.
- <u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption after publication in accordance with law.
