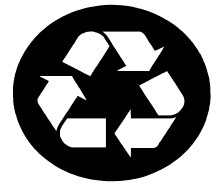

Trucks start their route at 5:00 AM. To avoid delays, please have your trash/recycling materials placed at the curb and ready for pickup by 5:00 AM of the scheduled day. For answers to questions call Meadowbrook Industries @ 732-774-0404.

**R**ecycling is now “Single Stream”. All items may share the same covered metal or plastic container marked with a decal or an “R” and placed at curbside (NOT IN TRASH RACK) at time of pickup. DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY TYPE. Single Stream includes Commingle, Paper & Cardboard items.

Commingle includes the following empty items with lids removed:

- all glass containers
- aluminum cans
- steel cans
- empty aerosol cans
- plastic bottles (neck must be smaller than the body of the container)

Paper (AKA Paper Stream) includes:

- Newspaper/inserts
- junk mail
- catalogs
- Cardboard
- writing paper
- magazines

Cardboard includes brown corrugated cardboard & brown paper bags. Must be empty and flattened. Please do not tie with string or tape.

**NO** ceramics; mirrors; light bulbs; stoneware; plastic wrappers; plastic buckets or bags; breakfast cereal boxes; pizza boxes; paper cups; Styrofoam; VCR tapes; waxed cardboard; plastic binders; paper towels/tissues; photographs; garden hose; plastic egg cartons; plastic caps; paper milk/juice cartons; drink boxes; straws; plastic or metal coat hangers; dishes & cookware; take out food containers; stickers or sheets of address labels; frozen food, ice cream or frozen juice containers; plates or vases; plastic 6-pack holders; drinking glasses or window glass; foam/popcorn packaging; plant trays; waxed paper; Tyvek envelopes.

**P** Telephone books – Will be picked up separately May 16<sup>th</sup> and October 10<sup>th</sup>. Please do not mix-in with Single Stream items.

**B** Brush and leaves are separate pick ups. Brush must be tied into manageable bundles, no heavier than 50 lbs., and no longer than 4 feet in length. Limbs and tree cuttings are to be no bigger than 3” in diameter.

Leaves, pine needles are to be bagged or canned and placed at curb.

DO NOT MIX ANY DEBRIS or GARBAGE WITH BRUSH OR LEAVES!



### BARBECUE PROPANE BOTTLES

Will **NOT** be picked up at the curb. They must be taken to a propane dealer for disposal.

### OCEAN COUNTY RECYCLING

The following items can be recycled by residents at the County recycling center on Recovery Road, Manahawkin, Monday - Friday 7:30am-3:00pm:

- tires/charge may apply
- motor oil/filters
- fluorescent bulbs
- empty paint cans
- rechargeable or button batteries

### TRASH

#### **TRASH ENCLOSURES –**

Trash and recycling enclosures shall not exceed 4 feet in height, and be no higher than 18 inches from grade on the pickup side.

#### **BULK REMOVAL –**

Bulk items such as furniture and mattresses must be placed at the curb for pickup. NO BULK REMOVAL DURING JULY AND AUGUST. Bulk pickup will resume the week after Labor Day.

#### **WHITE GOODS (appliances) –**

Please call Public Works at 609-494-6905 to schedule a pick up for appliances. Appliances include washers, dryers, refrigerators, a/c, etc. NO PICKUPS DURING JULY AND AUGUST.

#### **TV'S, COMPUTERS (electronics) –**

Effective January 1, 2011 all electronics are banned from landfills. Please call Public Works at 609-494-6905 to schedule a pick up. Electronics include: TV's, computers, computer peripherals, stereos, microwaves, phones, copiers, fax machines, etc. NO PICKUPS DURING JULY AND AUGUST.

#### **WOOD –**

Junk wood must be tied into manageable bundles, no heavier than 50 lbs., and no longer than 4 feet in length. It will be picked up as bulk trash.

#### **REMINDER –**

Construction debris (interior/exterior) must be removed by the owner and/or contractor.

#### **Please Remember:**

**Seagulls and Wind** are our biggest litterbugs. Please keep this in mind when putting out paper materials and please use trash can lids (it's the law).
