

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED "GENERAL LICENSING" AS IT PERTAINS TO VETERAN BEACH BADGES AND SPECIAL ACTIVITY FEES

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 4-3 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, 1975, Entitled "Beach Fees" is hereby amended by supplementing Section 4-3.5 as follows:

4-3.5 Badge Fees Waived for US Veterans. Free daily beach admission shall be provided to any person who has served in any of the Armed Forces of the United States and who was discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable and who either has served at least 90 days in active duty or has been discharged or released from active duty by reason of a service-incurred injury or disability upon presentation of acceptable proof of discharge to any badge-checker or Borough personnel.

Section 2. Section 4-7 entitled "Activity Committee Fees" is hereby amended as follows:

Event Admission Ticket \$1.00 to \$50.00

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, section or provision of this ordinance shall be found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section or provision shall be severable from the balance of the ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication in accordance with law.




