ORDINANCE NO. 2017-20

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED "WATERFRONT REGULATIONS" AS IT PERTAINS TO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON THE BEACH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 10-1.2 entitled "Definitions" is hereby amended by supplementing the following definition in alphabetical order:

Authorized vehicle shall mean the following vehicles:

- 1. Any vehicle operated by employees of the Borough, State and Federal government, and emergency services personnel.
- 2. Any vehicle operated by contracted personnel.
- 3. Permitted vehicles as defined in Chapter 4-2 Licensing of Beach Vehicles.
- 4. Electric motorized beach wheelchairs not exceeding 1 HP. No wheelchair shall be operated on the beach at a speed in excess of five miles per hour.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Section 10-7 entitled "Prohibited Activities" paragraph a. is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - a. The operation of any motor vehicle in the beach-dune area except for authorized vehicles.
- Section 3. All of the provisions of Chapter 10 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, 1975, not consistent herewith, are reaffirmed and readopted as if more fully set forth herein, and any provisions of said Ordinance which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- <u>Section 4</u>. If any provision, section, subsection, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, invalid, or inoperative, in whole or in part, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision, section, subsection, or paragraph shall to the extent that it is not unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative, remain in full force and effect, and no such determination shall be deemed to invalidate the remaining provisions, subsections, or paragraphs of this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 5</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption after publication in accordance with law.
