The April 15 – 16<sup>th</sup> storm did less damage than anticipated as the winds were southeast along our coast. Our beaches are still very vulnerable with many complaints of lack of beach affecting rentals.

The vast majority of the Harvey Cedars property owners are strongly in favor of the replenishment project. We hope the remaining 19 non-easement signers will consider the welfare of the whole town.

## ***Summer Safety Information***

- Effective March 1, 2006, New Jersey's Bicycle Helmet Law has changed. Young people under the age of 17 will be required to wear an approved helmet when cycling, roller skating, in-line skating, or skateboarding.
- Rollerblading and skateboarding are prohibited on Long Beach Blvd. in Harvey Cedars.
- Remember to wear your safety belt whenever you are in a vehicle. Harvey Cedars police participate in the "Click It or Ticket" Program.
- Be alert for pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Walkers and joggers should *face* the traffic and bicyclists *go with* the traffic.

## **SECURITY INFORMATION**

Harvey Cedars Police Department is offering a Residential Security Survey of your home. Please call for more information. Here are a few tips to keep in mind:

1. Always lock your car. It takes a thief less than 10 seconds to open your door and remove your personal belongings.
2. Keep your personal belongings out of sight. Lock them in your trunk.
3. Don't leave your bicycles where they can be easily taken, park them behind the house.
4. Many burglars will spend no longer than 60 seconds trying to break into a house. Good locks and good neighbors can be big deterrents to burglars.
5. If something looks suspicious, like a slit screen, a broken window or an open door, DON'T go in. Call the police from your neighbor's house or your cell.
6. When going to the beach leave your valuables locked in your car or house, and always keep your children in sight.
7. Report any suspicious activity to the police.
