Beach Replenishment Update

Things are moving along well considering there have been 52 “weather days” when the dredge had to leave for safety. Projected completion is early June. About the walkovers, street ends with abundant vegetation will remain natural with snow fence up to the crest of the dune. Street ends that were already defoliated or eroded will have round rail fencing and a walking surface that will be compacted to make access easier for all but walkways will be narrower than Surf City’s. Obviously, there were certain parameters to work within for the walkovers. We will be addressing concerns as they arise.

Dogs on Beach Ordinance

The ordinance banning dogs on the beach in the summer season is up for review. A significant number of taxpayers have contacted the Commissioners to consider allowing dogs on the beach in the summer with restrictions. Suggestions have included:

- ❖ Restrict dogs to certain designated early and/or late hours (e.g. before 8am, after 6pm)
- ❖ Restrict dogs to certain designated beaches
- ❖ Require the equivalent of beach badges – that is, you need to have purchased a permit to have a dog on the beach – the theory being to subsidize any additional cost of patrolling after (or during) the designated hours
- ❖ Restrict dogs to residents or renters of Harvey Cedars
- ❖ Odd numbered days – dog friendly during designated hours
- ❖ Even numbered days – no dogs allowed
- ❖ Some combination of the above

Bicycle Safety
