ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 13 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED "ZONING" AS IT PERTAINS TO DEFINITIONS, DRIVEWAYS, EASEMENTS, AND PERMIT FEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 13-3 entitled "DEFINITIONS" is hereby amended by inserting the following definition in alphabetical order:

EASEMENT, DRAINAGE shall mean the lands required for the installation of stormwater sewer or drainage ditches and/or required for the preservation or maintenance of a natural stream or watercourse or other drainage facilities.

Section 2. Section 13-7.4 entitled "Easements" paragraph d. is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

d. Every lot created pursuant to this subsection shall have a minimum area of 5,000 square feet. In computation of such area, no portion of a street or easement shall be included. The area of a lot designated as a drainage or utility easement may be used towards lot coverage and habitable area calculations provided the easement is not also an access easement.

Section 3. Section 13-9.6 entitled "Off-Street Parking Requirements" paragraph c. is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

c. No driveway shall exceed 18 feet in width at the street line, clearly designated by striping, paving, or otherwise delineating the selected 18 feet of driveway area. Only one driveway shall be permitted for each 50 feet of lot width. Lots exceeding 70 feet at the street line are permitted either one eighteen-foot driveway or two twelve-foot driveways. Distance between the two twelve-foot driveways must be a minimum of 20 feet at the street line for the purpose of maximizing street parking. Properties fronting on access easements are exempt from driveway delineation requirements.

Section 4. Section 13-16.2 of the Code of the Borough of Harvey Cedars entitled "Certificates and Permits" paragraph a. "Zoning Permits" is hereby amended by supplementing the following:

(o) Driveway permit – \$25.00

<u>Section 5</u>. This Ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or part of parts thereof.

Section 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

<u>Section 7</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption after publication in accordance with law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED "GENERAL LICENSING" AS IT PERTAINS TO PICKLEBALL COURT FEES

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 4-8.1 of the Revised General Ordinance of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, entitled "Fees Established", paragraph m. is hereby repealed in its entirety and readopted as follows:

m. Pickleball

All persons playing pickleball shall purchase a Pickleball Pass at the following rates:

- 1. Harvey Cedars Property Owner/Resident shall present their Harvey Cedars non-senior beach badge to obtain a Pickleball Pass (Limit 6 per household)
- 2. Non-Owner/Resident \$100 per season, \$20 per week, \$10 per day
- 3. Replacement Pickleball Pass fee: \$5 per pass
- <u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- <u>Section 3</u>. If any word, phrase, clause, section or provision of this ordinance shall be found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section or provision shall be severable from the balance of the ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- <u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication in accordance with law.

AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUATION OF OUTDOOR DINING AND SEATING IN THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS FOR THE YEAR 2023

WHEREAS on March 24, 2020 the Borough of Harvey Cedars declared a State of Emergency due to the outbreak of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, and subsequently issued Harvey Cedars Executive Orders for outdoor dining; and

WHEREAS Governor Phil Murphy has signed Bill (S-2364) to authorize a continuation of outdoor dining as a result of COVID-19 pandemic, and

WHEREAS the Governing Body of Harvey Cedars continue their commitment of support for the Borough's small businesses and economy, including, but not limited to, the restaurants and their owners and employees located in the Borough; and

WHEREAS in order to further protect the public's health, welfare, and safety, support the seasonal economy and restaurants, and support the Borough's position as a premier summer destination for families, the Borough deems it necessary to authorize the continuation of outdoor restaurant seating and serving areas for the 2023 season.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the aforesaid recitals and regulations outlined in previously adopted Resolution #2022-021, and the Borough of Harvey Cedars Executive Orders of 2020, which are incorporated herein by reference, it is hereby authorized that outdoor dining is permitted to continue for the 2023 season subject to the following:

- 1. Restaurants, with year 2022 approved seating plan, may continue to operate on the same approval given by the Governing Body as long as no changes are proposed. Restaurants seeking changes to prior approval, or wishing to create and/or expand outdoor seating areas will need to submit new applications for the 2023 season.
- 2. First-time applications or change submissions for the 2023 season will be required to abide by the regulations stipulated in previously adopted resolution #2022-021. Applications are available by request from the Clerk's Office.
- 3. For purposes of this Resolution, restaurants shall mean any commercial establishment approved for interior seating and in-person dining.
- 4. All outdoor seating areas shall be closed to all lawful permitted activities, including dining, by the restaurant on or before 11:00 p.m. each day.
- 5. Each specific violation of this Resolution shall be considered a separate violation, the owners of restaurants shall be subject to potential multiple violations during the course of each day, and each day in violation shall be considered a separate violation.
- 6. The Emergency Management Coordinator, the Borough Police Department, and the Construction Department shall be charged with the enforcement of the terms of this Order.
- 7. Unless otherwise expressly provided by this Resolution, all terms and requirements of the Borough Code shall continue to apply to the restaurants and the proposed structures, including, but not limited to, construction permits for the installation of any proposed structures at the restaurant property. The Borough shall have absolute discretion to amend any approval, condition, and restriction set forth in this Order.

8. Applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the Borough, its employees, agents, and/or officers from all claims, losses, liens, expenses, suits and attorney's fees arising out of the placement, operation, and maintenance of the Outdoor Seating Area. Applicants must name the Borough, its employees, agents, and /or officers as additional insureds under the Applicant's general liability insurance, bodily injury, property damage, and personal injury insurance policies, required to have a minimum limit of One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars, and provide proof of same to the Borough Clerk, and proof that said policies have been amended to reflect the coverage for the proposed outdoor dining area.
