### PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR -

Commissioner Imperiale stated that the Harvey Cedars Police Department just finished up their annual audit and no recommendations were made which means that everything is in compliance. Kudos to the entire Department.

Commissioner Rice also stated that the Borough is currently going through their annual audit which should be completed next week. No issues were found so far.

Walt Naisby, 82<sup>nd</sup> Street asked if there was any update on the NJ Right to Carry Law. Commissioner Imperiale stated that although there has not yet been a final ruling by the Governor, he is advising local businesses to post signs prohibiting firearms within private establishments. Business owners should be aware that they have the right to prohibit firearms within their establishments as long as signs are posted prohibiting firearms inside.

Mayor Oldham mentioned the loss of longtime resident, Davida Weiner. Davida, better known as Davie will be missed by the Harvey Cedars Community.

Mayor Oldham also gave an update on progress in obtaining signed easement agreements for the Streetscape Project. We are currently waiting on only two more agreements before we can move forward with the County. Improvements are planned for beach access points throughout Harvey Cedars before the summer season. The Department of Transportation will also be making make some improvements to local streets including the addition of a new crosswalk at James Street as requested by Commissioner Imperiale.

Fred Schragger, Salem Ave., expressed his interest in either filling the vacancy on the Open Space Committee or possibly acting as an advisor for the committee. All three of the commissioners said that a conversation with Ed O'Connor, Chairperson for the committee regarding the vacancy would be had.

#### **RESOLUTION #2023-029**

## AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS AND THE TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH FOR THE PROVISION OF A MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, NJSA 40A:65-1 et. seq., authorizes municipalities to agree to provide shared services when approved by resolution under NJSA 40A:65-5; and

WHEREAS in 2014 the Borough of Harvey Cedars entered into an agreement with the Township of Long Beach, the Boroughs of Beach Haven, Surf City, Ship Bottom and Barnegat Light for the provision of a Municipal Transportation System and designated the Township of Long Beach as lead agency; and

WHEREAS the Borough acknowledges and confirms that the Transportation System has become a vital part of the Island and has been a substantial benefit to all the residents, businesses and visitors; and

**WHEREAS** the Borough recognizes the Township of Long Beach as lead agency has borne the financial burden of operating said system; and

WHEREAS the Borough has agreed to a contribution share for the 2023 calendar year with the understanding and expectation that the Transportation System is to move toward self-sufficient operation without future municipal contributions in the near future; and

**WHEREAS** it is the desire of the Borough to continue said services and to renew the agreement with the Township of Long Beach.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Shared Services Agreement with the Township of Long Beach for the Municipal Transportation System, a copy of which is on file with the Borough Clerk, in accordance with the provisions of law for the initial term of one year commencing May 1, 2023 and terminating April 30, 2024 with optional renewal terms as more fully defined in said Agreement.

## **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** as follows:

- 1. In accordance with Section 2.02 of said agreement, the Borough of Harvey Cedars hereby designates Sunset Park, Harvey Cedars as a regular stop to pick up passengers during the operation schedule for the Transportation System.
- In accordance with Long Beach Township and due to budgetary constraints, payment of \$10,000 shall be made immediately and the remainder shall be paid in November.
- 3. The Borough of Harvey Cedars will continue to support the Transportation System provided there is documented progress observed to its self-sufficiency within the next 2 years.
