HARVEY CEDARS, NJ

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, NJ was called to order by Mayor Oldham at 4:30pm. Commissioners Imperiale and Rice were present.

The Mayor asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor stated to the best of his knowledge all the requirements of the Sunshine Law have been met. Pursuant to the applicable portions of the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, adequate notice of this meeting has been given. The schedule of this meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars is listed in the notice of meetings posted on the bulletin board located in the Borough Hall and the Borough's website and was published on December 9, 2021 in the Asbury Park Press and on December 16, 2021 in the Beach Haven Times, and republished with amendments on February 24, 2022 and March 8, 2022 respectively.

2. Wedding Ceremony – Sunset Park

A motion was made by Commissioner Imperiale, seconded by Commissioner Rice, to approve the request by Kelly Karch for a wedding ceremony at Sunset Park on Saturday, June 4, 2022 at 5pm, 30-40 guests.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR -

Al Donahower, West 76th Street, asked why there was an unsightly port-o-potty at the Bay beach; he said it is located close to the Yacht Club. The Mayor noted that it has been there for many years, but on the other side from the Yacht Club, and will find out why it was moved from its original location.

Joe Gieger, East 77th Street, presented a display of streetscape ideas including lampposts, a mayor's clock, and sidewalks with engraved bricks. A discussion followed addressing the ideas, the timing of the project, County approval, depressed curbing, and addressing the businesses. Also discussed was the brick program for the streetscapes and the park project. Jim Fritz of the Taxpayers Association stated the Association will promote the brick project. Mayor Oldham stated he was promised the engineer's survey and options of designs for the

streetscapes would be ready for the County to review in June. During the discussion Mr. Gieger predicted that in 2 years there will be a 25mph speed limit and 3 traffic lanes in Harvey Cedars due to the new Safe Passage law.

Jim Fritz asked the status of the 3-person committee ordinance. Fred Schragger stated he is working on it and will have a draft for re-introduction soon.

Jim Fritz stated the "ReClam the Bay" clam shell for Harvey Cedars is almost complete. A discussion was held regarding where to place the clamshell; it was determined the Taxpayers' Association will decide on a location.

Mr. Fritz stated some fulltime homeowners would like to see the construction hours the same as the summer season hours; they feel construction starting at 7:00AM during the winter months is too early and the hours of construction shouldn't be discriminated between summer rentals and year-round residents. A discussion with the public was held. Commissioner Imperiale stated the town is a vacation, resort, rental, and summer destination, but it is also a year-round community, and the regulations should reflect it is a year-round community that has a great summer business. The Board will continue to monitor the construction projects.

Fred Schragger gave opinions on the recent School Board meeting.

Commissioner Imperiale reminded all the next Police Forum is this Wednesday night at 5:00PM with Sergeant Snow's presentation of the department's administrative functions.

Mayor Oldham stated windscreens were ordered for the southside of the pickleball court; dozers are on the beach working on the erosion and walkovers due to the recent nor'easter storm; DPW is doing everything possible to get every walkover ready for the Memorial Day weekend.

Commissioner Rice stated the Fire Company's block party is June 11th; the setup will be very similar to the Striper Shootout event.

RESOLUTION #2022-055

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH AS THE LEAD AGENCY FOR LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION DATA

WHEREAS the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, NJSA 40A:65-1 et. seq., authorizes municipalities to agree to provide shared services when approved by resolution under NJSA 40A:65-5; and

WHEREAS the Township of Long Beach has agreed with the Borough of Harvey Cedars to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for access to the Long Beach Township Police Department "Vigilant LEARN" server in order to obtain License Plate Recognition information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Commissioner of Public Safety and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Shared Services Agreement with the Township of Long Beach as lead agency for access to the Long Beach Township Police Department Vigilant LEARN Server to download License Plate Recognition Data effective for a one (1) year period commencing January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022, with no option to extend.
- 2. The Borough of Harvey Cedars shall pay to the Township of Long Beach the following annual fees per unit, per the 2022 year:
 - a. \$600.00 for fixed camera access
 - b. \$250.00 per vehicle mounted ALPR system
- 3. A copy of the Agreement referenced herein shall be kept on file and made available for public inspection at the Municipal Clerk's Office during normal business hours.
