The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, NJ was called to order by Mayor Oldham at 4:30pm. Commissioners Imperiale and Rice were present.

The Mayor asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor stated to the best of his knowledge all the requirements of the Sunshine Law have been met. Pursuant to the applicable portions of the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, adequate notice of this meeting has been given. PRESENTATION – Joint Resolution from the New Jersey State Legislature

Commissioner Imperiale explained the Harvey Cedars Police Community Forums were planned a couple of years ago, however due to the COVID pandemic they were delayed; this year there were 6 forums held which were very successful. He stated he was not aware at that time of planning the forums, that both the New Jersey Senate and Assembly were considering a bill requiring police departments to meet with the community at least twice a year; the Legislators heard Harvey Cedars had met six times with the public before the passing of their bill; the resolution, which was sponsored by Senator Christopher J. Connors, Assemblywoman DiAnne C. Gove and Assemblyman Brian E. Rumpf, noted that every officer "participated in this worthy undertaking in 2022," and praised the members of the department as "individuals of strong character and uncommon determination." Commissioner Imperiale read aloud certain sections of the resolution, a full copy of which is attached, then presented the original framed resolution to Police Chief Burnaford. The Board and members of the public congratulated Chief Burnaford and the Officers.

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF OCEAN FOR PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES FOR THE 2023 ROAD & TRAFFIC LIGHT MAINTENANCE (SCHEDULE "C")

WHEREAS the County of Ocean has created and established a program to assist municipalities and governmental agencies in the repair and maintenance of municipal streets and property in addition to providing certain materials and supplies in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS the governing body of the Borough of Harvey Cedars has requested the County to provide certain materials and supplies for the maintenance of roads, property and traffic signals within the municipality for the year 2023 at a cost not to exceed \$11,000.00; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Harvey Cedars wishes to enter into an agreement with the County for the provision of these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Clerk of the Borough of Harvey Cedars are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County of Ocean for the provision of materials, supplies and services in an amount not to exceed \$11,000.00 as more specifically set forth in that Agreement and to be allocated as follows:
 - a. Ocean County Road Department \$ 10,000.00
 - b. Ocean County Engineering Department \$ 1,000.00
- 2. A copy of the Agreement shall be kept on file and be available for public inspection at the Office of the Borough Clerk.
- 3. This Agreement shall take effect upon full execution by the parties and shall remain in full force and effect through December 31, 2023. Sufficient funds have been appropriated and are available for this purpose in the 2023 municipal budget.
