

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-09

**AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE
REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY
CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED “POLICE REGULATIONS”**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF
THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS** as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-6 of the revised general ordinances of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, 1975, entitled “Wildlife Feeding” is hereby amended as follows:

3-6.2 Prohibited.

- A. No person shall feed, in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by the Borough of Harvey Cedars any wildlife, excluding confined wildlife (for example, wildlife confined in zoos, parks or rehabilitation centers, or unconfined wildlife at environmental education centers).
- B. No person shall feed wildlife, which shall include, but not be limited to, seagulls, ducks, squirrels, raccoons, Canada geese and waterfowl, on any private property.

Any person to be in violation of this ordinance shall be ordered to cease the feeding immediately.

Section 2. This Ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or part of parts thereof.

Section 3. If any provision, section, subsection, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, invalid, or inoperative, in whole or in part, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision, section, subsection, or paragraph shall to the extent that it is not unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative, remain in full force and effect, and no such determination shall be deemed to invalidate the remaining provisions, subsections, or paragraphs of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption after publication in accordance with law.
