Craig Coddington, Fire Company President, brought a sample post to show the Board of what could be used on the beach for street designation; there are about 30 streets. Jim Fritz, Vice President of the Taxpayers' Association, stated the Association will assist in the funding of

the signs. A discussion was held regarding the details of the installation and the purchase of the signs.

Kathleen Ries, President of the Taxpayers' Association, stated the Association is working with the LBI Joint Taxpayers to do an island-wide beach cleanup, which may happen on Mother's Day weekend Saturday; the plan is to meet at Sunset Park to get supplies for the cleanup then reassemble after the cleanup for refreshments. Superintendent Bill Montag and Ms. Ries discussed coordination of the event. A discussion continued regarding the cleanup, and dune grass planting in the Fall.

Commissioner Rice stated the budget is complete, and the municipal tax rate will stay flat this year.

Commissioner Imperiale stated there are great things coming in April, including the Police Forums; details will be announced soon.

Mayor Oldham stated he had his annual meeting with County; he said he had asked about the 3-lanes again; he also discussed the streetscapes with the Count, and is hoping to have the survey done by June for the County to review. The Mayor said Verizon should be fixing some of the problematic manholes soon.

The Mayor mentioned the atrocity going on in Ukraine, and said his thoughts and prayers are with those poor people.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED "SEWER AND WATER" AS IT PERTAINS TO BASE AND USAGE RATES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraphs A.1 and A.2 of subsection 7-2.4 entitled "Water Rate Schedule" of Section 7-2 entitled "Water Service" are hereby amended as follows:
 - 1. Quarterly base rate of ninety-five (\$95.00) dollars per dwelling unit
 - 2. Rate schedule (based on gallons used per meter):

Gallons Used	Rate Per Thousand (1,000) Gallons
0 - 14,000	\$1.70
14,001 - 25,000	\$1.85
25,001 - 50,000	\$3.35
50,001 - 150,000	\$4.80
150,001 - 300,000	\$6.90
Over 300,000	\$8.00

- <u>Section 2</u>. Paragraphs A.1 and A.2 of subsection 7-5.4 entitled "User Charges" of Section 7-5 entitled "Use of Public Sewers Charges" are hereby amended as follows:
 - 1. Quarterly base rate of eighty-five (\$85.00) dollars per dwelling unit
 - 2. Rate schedule (based on gallons used per meter):

Single Unit	\$1.90 per thousand gallons over 50,000 gallons
Duplex	\$1.90 per thousand gallons over 100,000 gallons
Triplex	\$1.90 per thousand gallons over 150,000 gallons
Quad	\$1.90 per thousand gallons over 200,000 gallons

- Section 3. All of the provisions of Chapter 7 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, 1975, not inconsistent herewith, are reaffirmed and readopted as if more fully set forth herein, and any provisions of said Ordinance which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 4. If any provision, section, subsection, or paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative, in whole or in part, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision, section, subsection, or paragraph shall, to the extent that it is not unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative, remain in full force and effect, and no such determination shall be deemed to invalidate the remaining provisions, subsections, or paragraphs of this ordinance.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption after publication in accordance with law.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS DENYING APPLICATIONS FILED BY VERIZON WIRELESS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SMALL WIRELESS FACILITIES

WHEREAS on February 14, 2022 New York SMSA Limited Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Verizon Wireless") filed two (2) applications pursuant to Chapter 23 of the Borough Code and the Borough designated said Verizon Applications as Nos. WF2022-01 and WF2022-02; and

Passaic Avenue is a street with limited poles working towards having all underground utilities. The proposed location is not conducive for a new or replacement pole. Suggestions for other locations other than on Passaic Avenue will be considered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, based upon the foregoing Recitals, which are incorporated herein by reference, the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, hereby denies Verizon Wireless applications WF2022-01, and WF2022-02 as submitted.
