RESOLUTION 2026-74

**A RESOLUTION URGING THE NEW JERSEY STATE LEGISLATURE AND
GOVERNOR TO REPEAL THE GAS TAX**

WHEREAS, the residents of the State of New Jersey and the Borough of Harvey Cedars are burdened by one of the highest overall tax structures in the United States; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, the State of New Jersey enacted legislation restructuring the Transportation Trust Fund and implementing an automatic adjustment mechanism commonly referred to as the "gas tax escalator"; and

WHEREAS, the gas tax escalator permits periodic increases in the motor fuels tax without a direct vote of the New Jersey State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, such automatic increases lack transparency and reduce accountability to taxpayers, who bear the financial burden without corresponding legislative oversight; and

WHEREAS, increases in the motor fuels tax raise the cost of commuting, goods, and services, and place additional financial strain on working families, seniors, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, these increased costs also impact municipal operations, including transportation, public works, and service delivery, thereby placing further pressure on local budgets and, ultimately, property taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Property Taxpayers Coalition has called for the repeal of the gas tax escalator as part of a broader effort to restore fiscal responsibility and taxpayer protections; and

WHEREAS, local governments have a responsibility to advocate for policies that protect their residents from unnecessary and unaccountable tax increases;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that it hereby urges the New Jersey State Legislature and the Governor to:

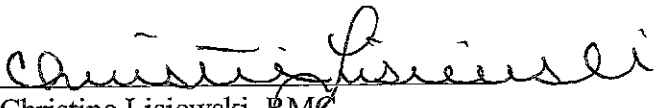
1. Repeal the gas tax escalator; and
2. Require that any future increases in the motor fuels tax be subject to a direct vote of the Legislature; and
3. Restore transparency and accountability in the taxation process affecting New Jersey residents;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Governor of the State of New Jersey, the Senate President, the Speaker of the General Assembly, the members of the New Jersey Legislature representing this district, and all municipalities within Sussex County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be made available to the public and shared with other municipalities as part of a coordinated effort to advocate for meaningful tax reform.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING A SHARED
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF STAFFORD FOR THE USE
OF OFF-DUTY OFFICERS FOR A PUBLIC PROJECT**

WHEREAS pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., the Borough of Harvey Cedars is authorized to enter into an agreement with any other municipality to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS there is an ongoing public roadway project in the Borough of Harvey Cedars which requires the employment of off-duty police officers for off-duty police related services pursuant to the terms of the project's contract; and

WHEREAS the scope of the required employment of off-duty officers exceeds the manpower of the Borough of Harvey Cedars' Police Department; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Harvey Cedars desires assistance from the Township of Stafford Police Department for employment of off-duty police officers; and

WHEREAS the Township of Stafford has agreed to allow its police officers to perform off-duty employment related to the Public Roadway Project in the Borough of Harvey Cedars.

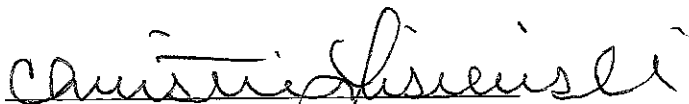
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars hereby agrees to enter into a shared services agreement related to the Public Roadway Projects with Stafford, and agrees to the following material terms:

1. Township of Stafford police officers shall be authorized to perform the required services related to the Public Roadway Project in the Borough of Harvey Cedars;
2. The Borough of Harvey Cedars shall serve as the lead agency and contract with the contractor for the required services;
3. The Township of Stafford shall provide Harvey Cedars the name of the officer(s) when scheduled for duty;
4. Said availability of Township of Stafford officers shall be without detriment to the Stafford Police Department schedule or to the citizens of the Township of Stafford;
5. Any party may terminate the agreement at any time during the term of the agreement with thirty (30) days written notice;
6. The terms of the Borough of Harvey Cedars' Code Section 2-5.2.j, attached hereto, shall govern and the compensation for the off-duty officers shall be paid by the Borough of Harvey Cedars to the Township of Stafford for the services provided by the off-duty officers;
7. Pursuant to Harvey Cedars' off-duty rates, compensation shall be a total of \$100 per hour with \$20 for administrative and \$80 for officer pay;
8. The Borough of Harvey Cedars shall remit payment to the Township of Stafford for any work performed by Stafford officers on a bi-weekly basis;
9. All off-duty officers shall remain employees of the respective parties, and shall use their respective equipment;
10. Each party shall be responsible for the continued insurance coverage relating to the services provided by their respective police officers, which shall be in addition to the insurance required to be provided by the contractor;
11. The term of this agreement shall be four (4) years.

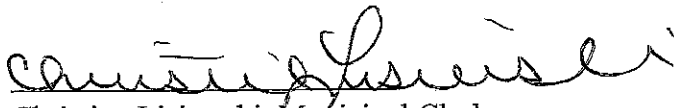

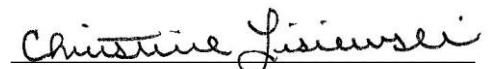

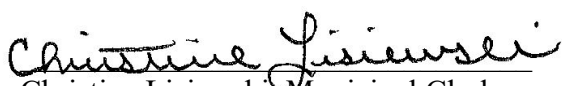
