The Mayor stated he was made aware of this last week, and will be scheduling meetings with the oceanfront homeowners regarding any issues of view, etc. for an expanded walkway on Bergen; this also has to be designed by the Borough Engineer for the correct slope. The Mayor stated this most likely won't take place this summer; the problem with just adding a mat on the drive over is that vehicles will ruin the mats.

Mayor Oldham stated the near shore project will begin in July; this is a pilot project using the sand from the inlet, dumping it off shore in Harvey Cedars; hopefully that sand will feed the beaches in lieu of piping in the sand; the Army Corps chose Harvey Cedars for this project because of the good relationship the Borough has had with the Corps.
