The Board responded that the Borough is auctioning old computers, trucks, etc. that are no longer needed. The e-management relates to recycling of electronics such as TV's, computers, computer monitors; manufacturers have a responsibility of recycling old electronics and the introduced bill will help enforce their obligations.

Art Ballinger stated that something should be done about the ruts on the beach made by the beach buggies; it is difficult to walk or lay on the beach, the beach is disgraceful; 63 buggy permits were sold for \$50 each and only 3 are from Harvey Cedars residents; the only time limitation is June, July & August; he asked the Board to come up with a solution for the future.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, COUNTY OF OCEAN, AUTHORIZING VERIZON WIRELESS TO USE EXISTING POLES IN THE BOROUGH'S RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, ("Verizon Wireless"), is a provider of commercial mobile service subject to regulation by the Federal Communications Commission; and

WHEREAS Verizon Wireless has entered into agreements with parties that have the lawful right to maintain poles in the public right-of-way pursuant to which Verizon Wireless may use such poles erected within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Harvey Cedars; and

WHEREAS New Jersey law permits such use provided that there is the consent of the relevant municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that permission and authority are hereby granted to Verizon Wireless and its successors and assigns, to use poles erected by parties that have the lawful right to maintain poles within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Harvey Cedars, subject to the following:

- A. Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall adhere to all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws regarding safety requirements related to the use of the public rightof-way.
- B. Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws requiring permits prior to beginning construction, and shall obtain any applicable permits that may be required by the Borough of Harvey Cedars.
- C. Such permission be and is hereby given upon the condition and provision that Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Borough of Harvey Cedars, its officers, agents, and servants, from any claim of liability or loss or bodily injury or property damage resulting from or arising out of the acts or omissions of Verizon Wireless or its agents in connection with the use and occupancy poles located within the public right-of-way, except to the extent resulting from the acts or omissions of the Borough of Harvey Cedars.
- D. Verizon Wireless shall, at its own cost and expense, maintain commercial general liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 for injury to or death of one or more persons in any one occurrence and \$500,000 for damage or destruction to property in any one occurrence. Verizon Wireless shall include the Borough of Harvey Cedars as an additional insured.

- E. Verizon Wireless shall be responsible for the repair of any damage to paving, existing utility lines, or any surface or subsurface installations, arising from its construction, installation or maintenance of its facilities.
- F. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein, neither the Borough of Harvey Cedars nor Verizon Wireless shall be liable to the other for consequential, incidental, exemplary, or punitive damages on account of any activity pursuant to this instrument.
- G. This instrument shall be adopted on behalf of the Borough of Harvey Cedars by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars and attested to by Borough of Harvey Cedars Clerk who shall affix the Borough of Harvey Cedars Seal thereto.
- H. The permission and authority hereby granted shall continue for the same period of time as the grant to parties whose poles Verizon Wireless is using.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, SUPPORTING BILLS S981 & A2375 AMENDING THE NEW JERSEY ELECTRONIC WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT

WHEREAS counties and municipalities are burdened with the expense and environmental impact of the existing New Jersey "Electronic Waste Management Act"; and

WHEREAS manufacturers of Covered Electronic Devices (CED) are not meeting their legal obligation to provide a free and convenient collection opportunity in each county; and

WHEREAS CED manufacturers are not fully supporting successful government programs by covering the full cost to collect and dispose of CEDs generated by consumers in accordance with the New Jersey "Electronic Waste Management Act"; and

WHEREAS the lack of support by CED manufacturers, has resulted in negative economic impacts to local government budgets and the elimination of longstanding successful collection programs; and

WHEREAS existing manufacturer supported private collection opportunities are insufficient and incapable of handling the overwhelming volume of material should government collection processes cease to operate; and

WHEREAS the elimination of government collection programs has serious potential to cause an increase in illegal dumping activities and the release of environmentally harmful materials contained in CEDs, due to the lack of drop off opportunities provided by CED manufacturers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, calls upon the members of the Senate, General Assembly and specifically the Governor of New Jersey, to support **Senate Bill S981** sponsored by Senator Bob Smith, District 17, (Middlesex and Somerset), Senator Christopher "Kip" Bateman, District 16 (Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex and Somerset), and **Assembly Bill A2375**, sponsored by Assemblyman John F. McKeon, District 27, (Essex and Morris County), amending the New Jersey "Electronic Waste Management Act" that would enable the continuation of government sponsored collection programs, free of charge to consumers and taxpayers, therefore fulfilling the intent of the original law. Certified copies of this resolution shall be transmitted to Senate and Assembly members, Governor Chris Christie, the New Jersey Municipal League and the Association of New Jersey Recyclers (ANJR).
